Celtic Knots with Holly Monroe (Part 2 of Uncials)

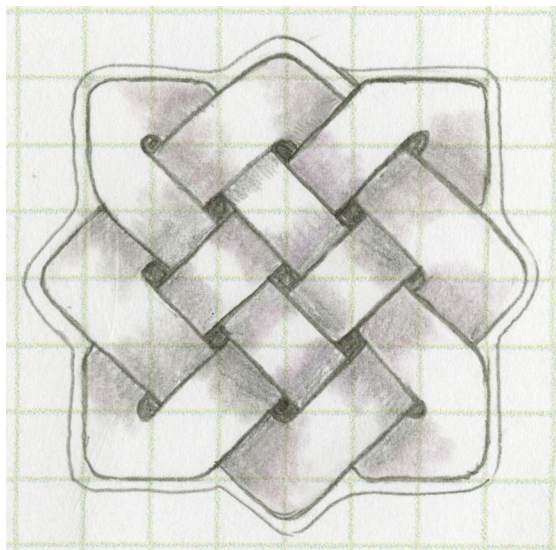

SUPPLY LIST

PAPER:

Print handouts as some are worksheets, 1/4" Grid paper, (8 printed from Holly's file or your own), Tracing Paper (2-3) 8.5x11 sheets, Saral Paper- (optional) to transfer artwork onto art paper or small light table
Your favorite fine art or drawing paper for small finished work

PENS & INK: *(optional - if you want to combine lettering with Celtic knots)*

Round wooden double-ended penholder
Mitchell Roundhand Nibs. Sizes mainly #3, 3.5, 2.5, 2,
Mitchell Brass Reservoirs
Your favorite ink or paint

PAINTING SUPPLIES: (to paint Celtic Knotwork)

Watercolor or Gouache- 3 favorite colors plus zinc white, black
Gum Arabic- if you are using gouache
Metallic Gold Gouache- or another metallic that goes with the above colors
Small paint brushes- pointed (approx sizes 1, 0) WN Series 7 or other
Paint mixing tray

FROM YOUR TOOLBOX:

Ruler
Stylus for making dots
Drawing pencil- HB lead or other. My fav is Pentel, GraphGear 500 0.5 or 0.7 HB
Pigma Micron or Millenial Pen- Small size .01 or .03 (for outlining)
Eraser- Mars Staedtler or other
Paint rag (paper towels)
Water Container to rinse pens (i.e. a small butter tub or glass jar)
Water dropper bottle with distilled water
Artist Tape

Pointed nib- Blue Pumpkin, 66EF, Nikko G or whatever pointed nib you prefer
Finetec metallic watercolour paint or Coliro Pearlcolors – at least 1 single small pan or a set
Small water container
Small cheap mixing brush
Pipette or water dropper
Zig 2 way glue pen, any tip size (chisel tip, bullet tip or fine tip). We will have some for you to try. You don't need all of them unless you want them all :)
Adhesive, either liquid or tape
Bone folder
Paper towel
Parallel Pen, any size (optional)
Fons & Porter white pencil or chalk pencil (optional)
